Directions to Cane Creek:

IMPORTANT – MAPS ARE DECEPTIVE – READ THESE DIRECTIONS!

Take Providence Road (Route 16) South to Waxhaw.

In downtown Waxhaw make a left after going over railroad track. Go through town, the road bears to the right and then the road will fork to the right, turn right. Go approximately 2 miles, pass Waxhaw Baptist Church Cemetery turn right (still Providence Rd.). Go approximately 5.5 miles crossing over Hwy 200 (Lancaster and Providence intersection). Follow signs to camping area/group camping area (you will come to the day use area first – CONTINUE PAST IT!)

- o work gloves for handling hobo meals

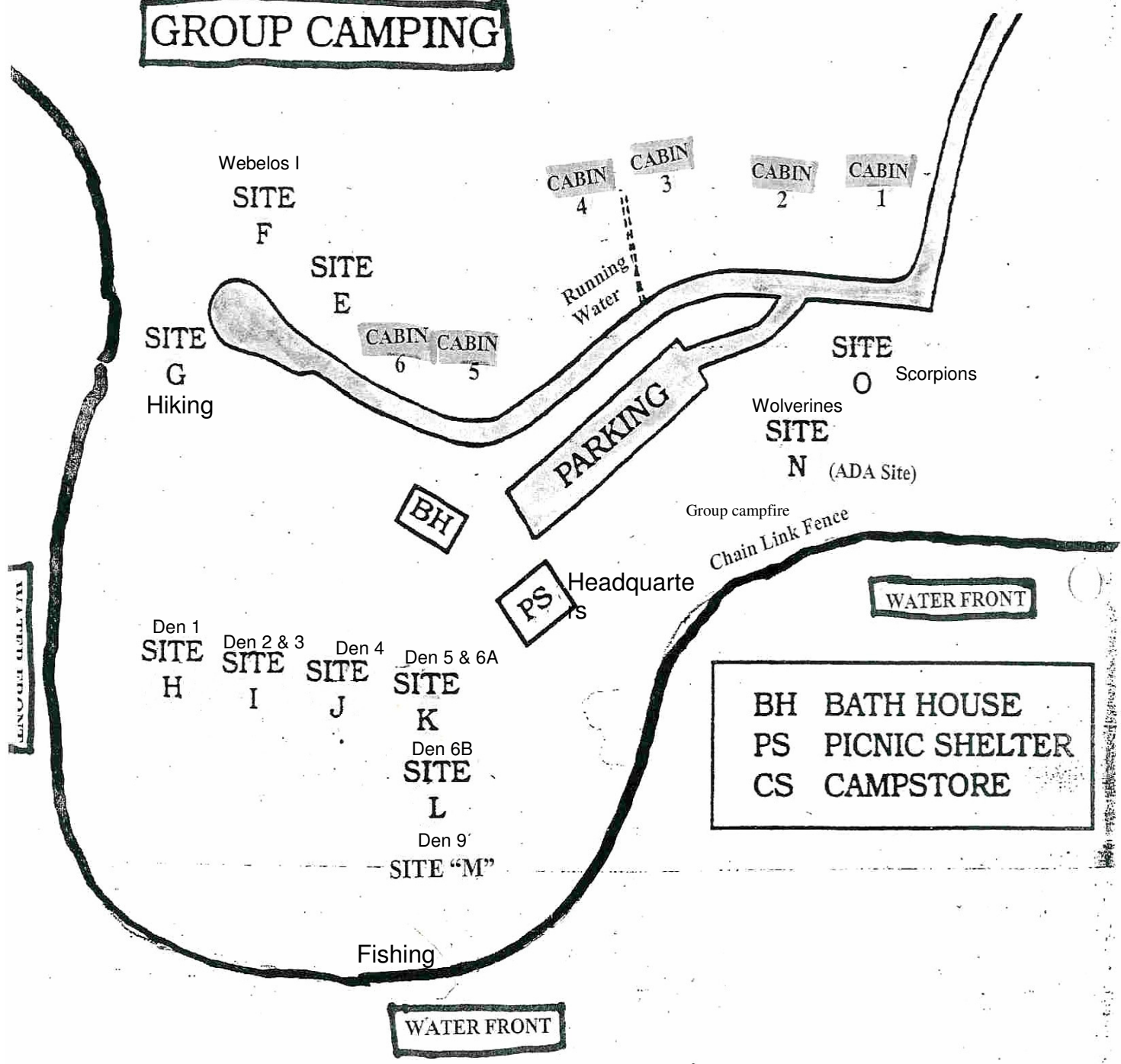
