 - Arrive in Charleston, SC @ the Yorktown 9 am.
 - Check in assembly in the Yorktown parking lot.

 - Tour ship/submarine/outdoor museum/gift shop by den.
 - NOON meet as a Pack for lunch aboard the Yorktown.
 - Afternoon bus ride and tour of the SC Aquarium.
 - 5-6pm ish dinner on board the Yorktown—exact time available when we arrive.
 - Saturday evening tour ship by den.
 - 8-9 ish pm MANDATORY SHIP SAFTY DRILL.
 - 10:30 lights out.
 - Sunday breakfast 7-8 am ish---exact time available when we arrive.
 - Sunday service 8:30 am.
 - 9 am depart ship and stow gear on busses.
 - 10:30 boat trip to Ft. Sumpter.
 - Noon leave on busses for lunch on own in Charleston, SC (fast-food).
 - 1 pm leave Charleston area for MUMC and arrive 4:30-5 pm.
